For the third year running bright* is pleased to be involved with the Honeymead Trust's recital at St. Mary Magdelene Church, Taunton. The event, organised by Sir Stephen Whaley-Cohen is a fundraiser for the charity.

The interior of the building poses many challenges. Equipment had to be floor mounted as there are no hanging positions, and equipment had to be low power due to the limited electrical supply.

bright* designed a system that provided stage lighting and focus to the musicians as well as ensuring they were able to see their music clearly. The system also extended further this year to light the interior of the building using a range of luminaires from bright*'s large LED stock.

"LED lighting offered the ability to reveal some of the architectural features of the interior in full colour", commented Lighting Designer Joe Rockett. "The benefit of this equipment is the fact that the colour can be remotely selected, and the fittings use very little electrical energy making them highly versatile pieces of equipment"

The lighting could be changed to suit the style and tone of the different musical pieces, and colour could be used to help set and change the atmosphere over the course of the event.



bright* was involved with the original relighting of the interior of the Church, which saw the older elements of the amenity lighting scheme replaced by a new architectural scheme that was carefully selected and installed to reveal the true architectural beauty of the interior.

"The choice of light fixtures had to be approved by the DAC due to the fact that we aimed to introduce contemporary fittings and light sources into the historic setting" comments Rockett. However, the choice of lamp and style of equipment met with approval and offers significant savings on running cost and replacement.
